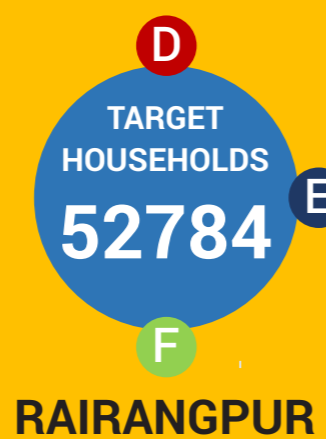

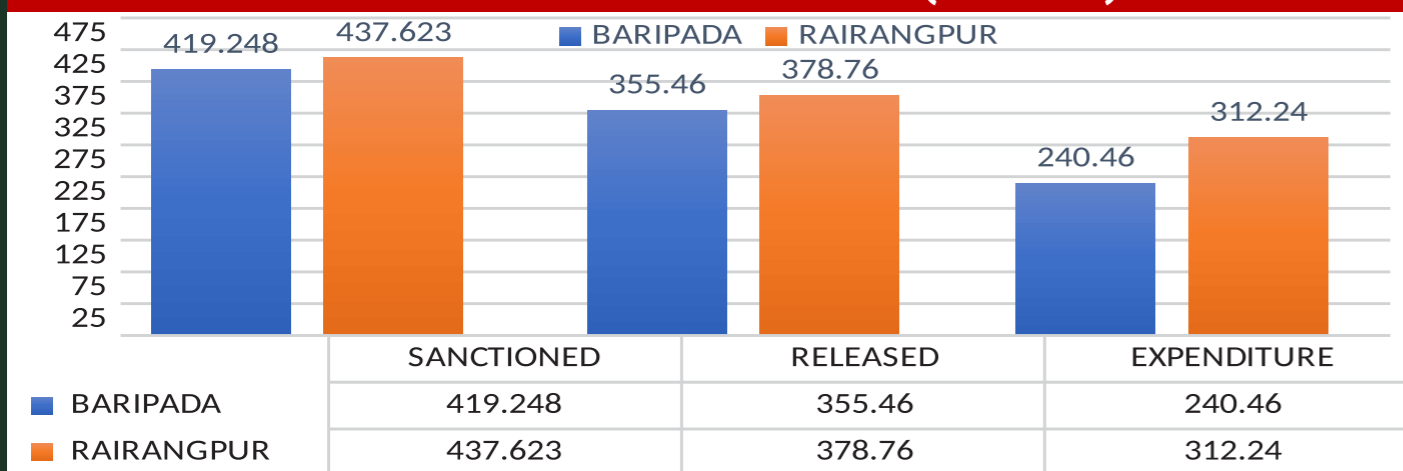

Some tribal-dominated region of Mayurbhanj district have been enduring a severe shortage of drinking water due to lack of perineal water sources, compelling them commute 5-10 kilometres to collect the drinking water which was often contaminated. This situation led to various health issues among the villagers. The PR&DW dept. devised an alternative strategy of providing potable water and named it Single & Multi Village scheme.

The proposal of Single & Multi Village scheme is being implemented through OMBADC funding and is being executed by the PR&DW Department covering 80 GPs of 7 Blocks (Bahalda, Bijatala, Bisoi, Jamda, Karanjia, Thakurmunda and Tiring) in Rairangpur Division and 76 GPs of 4 Blocks (Betanoti, Morada, Rasgobindapur & Suliapada) in Baripada Division. The project has been initiated by the dept. from October 2022.
